Families new to California may not realize that California school children are required to be fully vaccinated in order to attend public or private school, regardless of their parents' personal or religious beliefs. Schools will not admit students to private or public elementary or secondary schools, childcare centers, or nursery schools without full immunization.

MILITARY STUDENT IDENTIFIER

The Military Student Identifier (MSI) requires states to identify and track the test scores, attendance, and graduation rates of militaryconnected students, defined as students with a parent who is an active duty member of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard and National Guard. 


