


Monthly School Liaison Newsletter

School Transfer Window for MPUSD

High School Transfer Window Now Open!

Planning ahead for next school year? The transfer window for the 2026–2027 school year is officially open November 10 – December 12, 2025.

This is especially important for current 8th graders who will be entering high school next fall! Families wishing to transfer from one MPUSD high school to another must complete an online transfer request during this period.

Important: This is the only opportunity to request a transfer to the high school of your choice within MPUSD for the upcoming school year, and approvals are based on space availability. As for TK – 8th Grade: Mark your calendars! The TK–8th Grade Student Transfer Window **OPENS January 12, 2026.** We will keep you posted with any transfer updates.
